**Order and Conditions of Adult Probation**

As to court case: [REDACTED], [REDACTED] having been convicted of [REDACTED] is this day ORDERED sentenced to probation for a period of FIVE YEARS unless terminated by the Court prior to the maximum expiration date.

While on probation, said defendant is ORDERED to comply with the following conditions and any others which the Court may impose at a later date and to follow the instructions of the probation officer as to the way in which these conditions are to be carried out.

**General Conditions:**

1. Report to probation officer as directed by the Court or the probation officer and permit the probation officer to visit his or her place of abode or elsewhere;
2. Remain within the jurisdiction of the Court unless granted permission to leave by the Court or the probation officer;
3. Answer all reasonable inquiries by the probation officer and notify the probation officer prior to any change in address or employment;
4. Refrain from violating any federal, state or local law: notify the probation officer if arrested or questioned by any law enforcement official;
5. Avoid injurious or vicious habits;
6. Refrain from frequenting unlawful or disreputable places;
7. Refrain from consorting with disreputable persons;
8. Work faithfully at a suitable employment or pursue a course of study or vocation training that can lead to suitable employment;
9. Support his or her dependents and meet other family responsibilities;
10. Obey the directions given by the probation officer to insure compliance with the Conditions of Probation;
11. Submit to periodic tests to determine whether alcohol and/or controlled substances are being used;
12. Undergo inpatient or outpatient medical, alcohol, substance abuse or psychiatric and or mental health evaluations and/or treatment as recommended by probation and remain in a specified institution or program until satisfactory completion, including all aftercare deemed necessary. Consent to the release of all alcohol, substance abuse, medical and mental health information from that treatment provider to the Probation Department;
13. Submit to a warrantless search of your person, property, residence or vehicle under probationer's control, by a probation officer and his or her agent (Section 2.20 of the New York State Criminal Procedure Law);
14. Do not possess or own concealed bladed instruments, weapons, ammunition, or simulated firearms, including but not limited to those defined in Section 265.00 of the New York State Penal Code, without express permission of the Court or the Probation Department;
15. **Excluding those adjudicated as Youthful Offenders**, submit to the appropriate DNA testing by providing a DNA sample suitable for testing for the Convicted offender Index, as mandated by the Executive Law 995-c for designated offenders OR provide a DNA sample suitable for testing for the Subject Index as authorized by Title 9NYCRR part 6192.
