CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

- 1. The probationer will obtain permission from the Probation Officer before changing his or her address or employment or before leaving the State.
- 2. The probationer will make a complete and truthful report to the Probation Officer in person or in writing as directed.
- 3. The probationer shall not possess or use alcoholic beverages or controlled substance drugs unless prescribed for you by a licensed physician or visit places where intoxicants or drugs are unlawfully sold, dispensed or used.
- 4. The probationer shall not associate with persons of bad character or be in places of business whose primary purpose is the sale of alcoholic beverages (taverns, bars, etc.).
- If convicted of a felony, the probationer shall not receive, own, possess, ship or transport any firearm or ammunition.
 (Ref. Gun Control Act of 1968, Public Law 90-618Title I, section 922 entitled "Unlawful Acts.") All other probationers require express permission of the Court for use of firearms.
- 6. The probationer shall report all arrests, including traffic violations, regardless of disposition, to the Probation Officer.
- 7. The probationer shall allow the Probation Officer to visit his or her home, job site, or elsewhere and carry out all instruction given by the Officer, whether oral or in writing.
- 8. The probationer shall obey the laws of the United States, and the laws of any State or Municipality the probationer is located.
- 9. The probationer shall not be away from his or her place of residence at late or unusual hours of the night, such hours to be determined by the Probation Officer who will also give permission for night employment if necessary.
- 10. The probationer shall pay all costs imposed by the Court, and or by the State or County in connection with this case.
- 11. The probationer shall work diligently at a lawful occupation and support his or her dependents, if any, to the best of his or her ability OR be enrolled as a full-time student in pursuit of a career goal during the term of his or her probation period.
- 12. The probationer shall be required to observe any special conditions imposed by the Court or the Probation Officer and or listed elsewhere on this document.
 - a. Probationer may be required to deposit twenty (\$20.00) dollars with Probation Office to be used on Random Drug Screens.
 - b. Special Conditions
- 13. \$45.00 per month fee for clients placed on probation on diversion pursuant to TCA 40-35-313. Payment can be made in cash or money order only, no personal checks. Failure to pay the required fee may result in revocation of probation proceedings.

Violation of any of the terms of probation may be sufficient cause for the probationer to be taken into custody and brought before the Court on a hearing for revocation.

I have read or have had read to me the conditions of my probation. I fully understand them and agree to comply with such conditions during the period of probation. Further, I hereby waive all extradition rights and process and agree to return to Tennessee if at anytime prior to my discharge from probation the Trial Judge directs me to do so.
